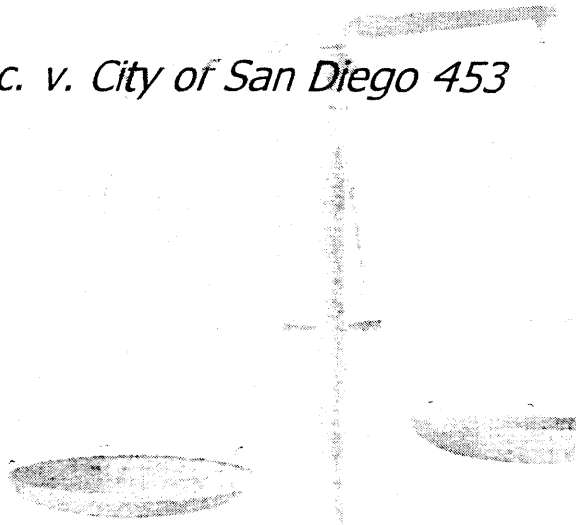
- *Members of the City Council of Los Angeles v. Taxpayers for Vincent*

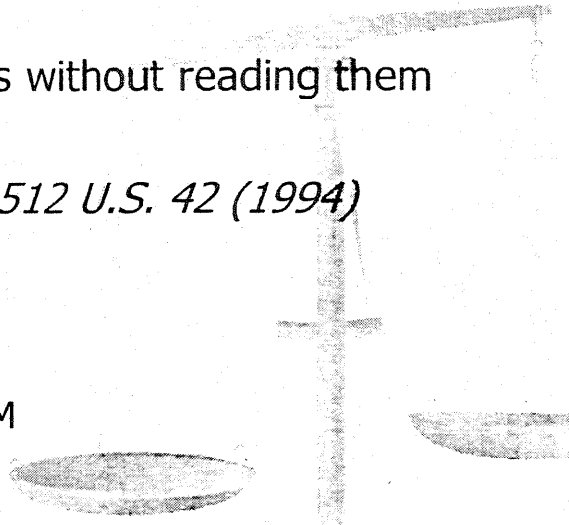

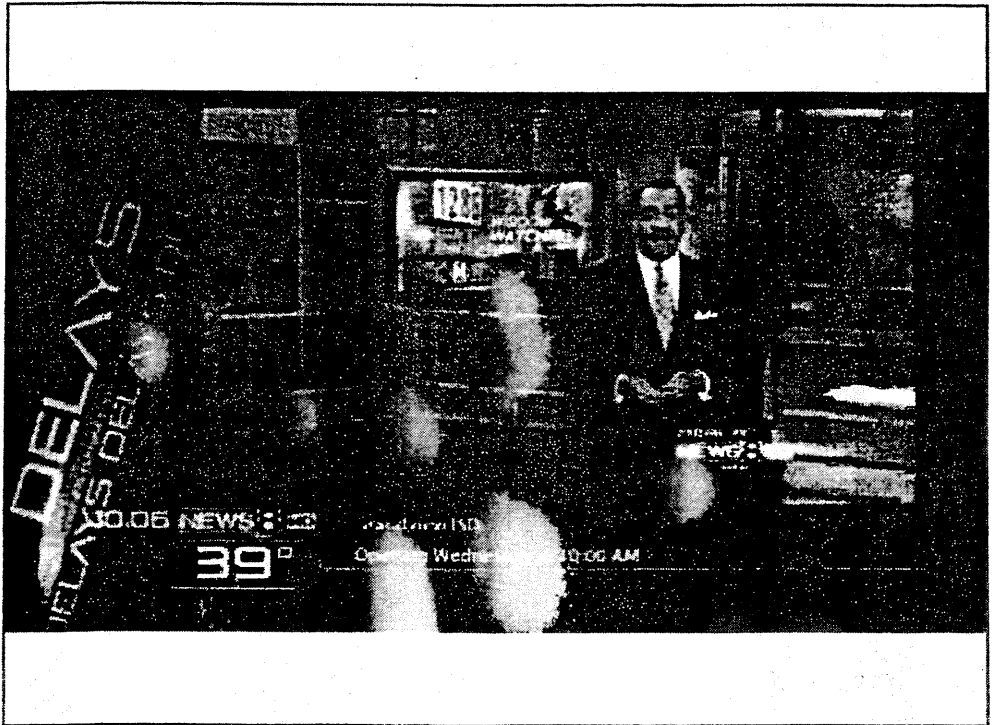
