





















COMPLAINT REQUIREMENTS


- ♦Name of the Accused

- Committed in the Territorial Limits of the City
- ♦Date of Offense
- ◆That the Affiant has Good Reason and, Does Believe, that the Accused has Committed the Offense
































Complaints are required to have the following

- Complaint shall begin with "In the name and by the Authority of the State of Texas."
- Complaint shall conclude with "Against the peace and dignity of the State."
- If Complaint alleges an Ordinance violation, it shall also conclude with "Contrary to the said Ordinance.








CULPABLE MENTAL STATE?

- What if the definition of an offense does not prescribe a culpable mental state but one is required?
- The required culpable mental state must be intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly criminally negligent.


COMPLAINT MUST BE SIGNED


- Rubber Stamped Signature
- Electronic Signature (Judge, Court Clerk, or Defendant)
- Not Signed = Defective Complaint













OBJECTIONS BY DEFENDANT

 Waives and forfeits the right to object to a defect, error, irregularity in form, or substance of the Complaint if the Defendant does not object before the commencement of the trial on the merits.
