- Signs on State Highway Rights-of-Way

 - J.P. Authority to Hear Related City Ordinance Violations in ETJ

 - Effective September 1, 2007

HB 1141

- Confidentiality of Certain Appraisal Records of Current and Former Peace Officers.
- Also applies to current or former district, criminal district, county, or municipal attorneys.
- Effective Immediately

HB 3558

- Fire, Health, Code Enforcement Warrants
- City or County may Designate *More Than One* Individual for the Purpose of Executing Administrative Search Warrant

HB 1355

- Dog Attacks on Persons
 - Amends the Health and Safety Code
 - Reclassifies Offenses
 - "Dangerous Dogs"
 - Defenses to Prosecution
- No Impact on Local Leash Ordinances
- Effective September 1, 2007

HB 1551

- Amends Civil Practice and Remedies Code 125.002(e): Remedies for Common Nuisances
- Effective Immediately

Other Municipal Related Bills

- HB 1784: Contacting Security Alarm Customers
- HB 2644: Injunction for Unlicensed Massage Therapy Establishments
- SB 352: Broadening the Method of Delivery for Notices Regarding Substandard Buildings
- SB 1238: Sale and Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages near Homeless Shelters and Substance Abuse Treatment Centers

HB 922

- Creates 542.2035 of the Transportation Code: Municipality May Not Enforce Compliance with Speed Limits with an Automated Traffic Control System.

Attorney General Enforces this Mandate.

Effective Immediately

SB 1119

- Red Light Cameras
- Creates Chapter 707 of the Transportation Code
- Effective September 1, 2007

HB 1052

- Creates 544.012 of the Transportation Code: Warning Signs at Intersections with Red Light Cameras
- Effective September 1, 2007
