Bond Conditions, CCP, 17.441

Driving While Intoxicated, Driving While Intoxicated with Child Passenger, Boating While Intoxicated, Flying While Intoxicated

Offense	Interlock Required
1 st	Discretion of Judge
.15 BAC or higher	Discretion of Judge
Subsequent	Yes, Mandatory

Intoxication Assault, Intoxication Manslaughter

Offense	Interlock Required
1 st	Yes, Mandatory
Subsequent	Yes, Mandatory

As a Condition of Probation (Community Supervision), CCP 42.12, Sec. 13(i)

Driving While Intoxicated, Driving While Intoxicated with Child Passenger, Boating While Intoxicated, Flying While Intoxicated

Offense	Interlock Required
1 st	Discretion of Judge
.15 BAC or higher	Yes, Mandatory
Subsequent	Yes, Mandatory Not less than 50% supervision period

Intoxication Assault, Intoxication Manslaughter

Offense	Interlock Required
1 st	Discretion of Judge
.15 BAC or higher	Yes, Mandatory
Subsequent	Yes, Mandatory Not less than 50% supervision period

Defendants under 21 years of age, if placed on probation, CCP, 42.12(n), Sec. 13; TRC 521.342(b)

Driving While Intoxicated, Driving While Intoxicated with Child Passenger, Boating While Intoxicated, Flying While Intoxicated

Offense	Interlock Required
1 st	Yes, Mandatory Not less than 50% supervision period
Subsequent	Yes, Mandatory Not less than 50% supervision period

Condition of Issuance of Occupational License, TRC 521.246

If Defendant has been convicted of an offense of DWI, Intoxication Assault, or Intoxication Manslaughter

Offense	Interlock Required
1 st	Discretion of Judge
Subsequent	Yes, Mandatory Not less than 50% supervision period

- Defendant shall obtain device before 30th day after arrest if on bond; or before 30th day after conviction if placed on probation.
